This is an agreement providing for the collection, transportation, and continued use of parts washer solvent under Universal Lubricants' Continued Use Program (CUP). Upon terms and conditions set forth in this agreement, Universal Lubricants, LLC (UL) shall provide service for the parts washer and the collection of the parts washer solvent.

Universal Lubricants' **Continued Use Program (CUP)**

Participation in this program eliminates the customer's solvent from being a waste provided the following requirements are met:

1. Customer and employees will be trained on the proper use of the parts washer, UL's CUP, and the importance of keeping foreign and/or inappropriate materials out of the washer.
2. Disposal of foreign and/or inappropriate materials in the CUP solvent parts washer will result in the requirement for additional training for the customer regarding proper handling of wastes. If the improper disposal continues, participation in the CUP program will be terminated. The presence of foreign and/or inappropriate materials will be determined by an (a) inspection of the solvent parts washer at servicing by UL employees and/or (b) analysis of a sample taken from the customer's solvent.
3. Detection of excessive solids in the solvent parts washer at servicing will result in the drum of solvent being rejected for the CUP. The disposal of the solvent will be the customers' responsibility.
4. Customer warrants that he or she shall not offer to UL for collection under the UL CUP, any substance other than the solvent described above.

This agreement shall commence upon the effective date of the agreement and shall continue thereafter until terminated by either party giving the other party ten (10) days written notice of termination, however, UL may immediately cancel the agreement in the event of a breach of customer's warranty regarding the solvent.

Customer's obligations with respect to the payment of expenses, fees, and costs, as well as its obligations to indemnify, as set forth above, shall survive the termination of this agreement. This agreement shall be executed under applicable state laws and regulations.

Customer has read and agrees to the terms and conditions of this agreement.
